In the present case, the petitioner has approached this Court claiming that after working as Class IV employee with respondents No. 4 and 5, she retired from service on 30.09.2017 and despite the fact that there is no impediment in release of the pensionary benefits, nothing has been released to her even after expiry of more than one year.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-1). He further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-1), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
