The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.66, dated 13.06.2018, registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on and Section 452 IPC substituted with Section 450 IPC later on), at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 14.06.2018. The investigation is complete, but the trial has not yet commenced and thus, the same is not likely to be concluded at an early date. The petitioner has no criminal antecedents and therefore, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned/Duty Judicial Magistrate, at Faridkot.
