The allegations of the petitioner are that respondents No. 4 to 6 have opened a bank account in the name of the petitioner and one Usha Monga showing her as daughter of the petitioner in the banks respondents No. 7 to 9. The concerned banks did not provide any information to the petitioner regarding opening of the said accounts and, therefore, he submitted a representation dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-9) in the office of respondent No. 2 but the police is not taking action thereupon.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. S.P. Singh, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondents No. 4 to 9.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 22.10.2018 (Annexure P-9) and to

take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
