The grievance of the petitioner is that during the period between 27.10.2017 and 2.11.2017, transactions amounting to ₹ 90 lacs have taken place from her account without the petitioner being aware of the said transactions. Although the Bank Manager was asked to investigate the matter but he did not take any action and, therefore, a representation dated 29.8.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, yet, no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is necessary to be issued to respondents No. 5 to 11.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to objectively consider the representation dated 29.8.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to take

appropriate action in accordance with law, if found necessary, within a period of eight weeks.
