The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 7 dated 11.1.2013, under Sections 308, 452, 354, 325, 323, 34 PC (Sections 307 and 506 IPC added subsequently and Section 308 IPC deleted) registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana City.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 15.1.2018. It is contended that the trial is underway and the material witness has been examined. It is also contended that as per the medical evidence and statement of PW7 Dr. Seema Chopra, no injury on the person of the complainant has been declared as dangerous to life and therefore, no offence under Section 307 is made out. It is further contended that the trial is likely

to take some time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent—State opposes the bail application while submitting that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender, however, she has not been able to deny the fact that the material witness has been examined.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that material witness has been examined and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
