In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for counting the service which the petitioner had rendered with respondent No.2 from 08.04.1981 to 15.07.1985 and then again from 07.05.1988 till 30.11.2008.

According to the averments made in the present writ petition, the petitioner has already been granted pension by computing his qualifying service from 07.05.1988 onwards but for the period for which the petitioner discharged the duties from 08.04.1981 to 15.07.1985 has been refused to be counted as a qualifying service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served upon the respondent a representation Annexure P-6 (dated NIL). He further states that the said representation has not been disposed of as yet and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner be given liberty to file a fresh detailed representation which will not only include the facts but also the law on the subject.

Permitted to do so. Let the petitioner file a detailed representation within a period of four weeks from today.

In case, any representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to dispose of the same by passing a speaking order within a period of three months.

However, it is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present writ petition or to be made in the representation to be filed.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
