ARUN MONGA, J. (Oral)

- 1.) *Inter alia* contends that Government of India vide order dated 16.08.2017 (Annexure P-3) had refused the contractual remuneration of the employees engaged on contract basis in ECHS whereby the monthly remuneration of a Dental Surgeon was enhanced from ₹ 60,000/- to ₹ 75,000/-. Notwithstanding the petitioner who is currently employed at ECHS Poly Clinic, Ludhiana has not been given the said benefit whereas, her colleague Dr. Jagmohan Singh has been granted the said benefit of enhancement as reflected from the pay bill dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-5).
- 2.) Notice of motion.
- 3.) At this stage, Mr. Shivoy Dhir, Senior Panel counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of Union of India-respondents.

- 4.) However, this Court is of the view that the present petition can

be disposed of without further proceedings/pleadings. Keeping in view the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner as noted above and also the averments in the writ petition read with the order dated 16.08.2017 (Anneuxre P-3) passed by Government of India whereby the contractual remuneration of the Dental Officers employed in ECHS was enhanced from ₹ 60,000/- to ₹ 75,000/-, respondent No.2 is directed to treat the present writ petition as representation of the petitioner and pass speaking order thereof within a period of 8 weeks from today.

5.) Petition stands disposed of.
