

**IOIN-CRM-M-10841-2017 in CRM-M-10841-2017 and
IOIN-CRM-M-16033-2017 in CRM-M-16033-2017**

Surender and another Vs. State of Haryana

The petitioners had approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.0049 dated 8.3.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Uklana.

Vide order dated 30.3.2017, while issuing notice of motion, the petitioners had been directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and had been granted interim bail. Subsequently, vide order dated 16.2.2018; upon noticing that Sub-Inspector Dara Singh, who had instructed the State counsel, had given incorrect information to the effect that the petitioners had not given copies of the sale-deeds, whereas infact the petitioners had already furnished the same on 4.9.2017, a direction was issued to Superintendent of Police, Hisar to explain as to what action had been taken against the said police official. Pursuant to the said order, an affidavit was filed in this Court on 6.3.2018 by Superintendent of Police, Hisar, wherein it was informed that departmental proceedings have been initiated against Sub-Inspector Dara Singh. Vide order dated 6.3.2018, a direction was issued to Superintendent of Police, Hisar to file an affidavit within a period of four months as regards the outcome of disciplinary proceedings initiated against Sub-Inspector Dara Singh for having furnished incorrect information to the State counsel. The

interim directions as regards grant of interim bail were, however, made absolute.

Today, a status report by way of affidavit of Ms. Manisha Chaudhary, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Hisar has been filed alongwith an order dated 18.6.2018 passed in conclusion of the departmental proceedings initiated against Sub-Inspector Dara Singh. A perusal of the said order shows that while holding the delinquent guilty, punishment of stoppage two annual increments with temporary effect, has been imposed upon the delinquent.

The departmental proceedings having been concluded, no further direction is required to be issued in context of order dated 6.3.2018 passed by this Court.

In view of the aforesaid position, the IOIN(s) stand disposed of accordingly.
