1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking quashing/staying of order dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) and for issuance of direction to stay and withdraw and/or cancel process initiated by the respondent-Bank in order to classify the account as Non Performing Assets (NPA).
2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as are available to her, in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the

petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to her, in
accordance with law.
