By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner at the instance of respondent No.4 and to protect his life and liberty and also a direction for getting his representation dated 1.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) decided in accordance with law.

The petitioner submitted that the petitioner had married respondent No.4 on 11.03.2018 but later on it transpired that respondent No.4 was already married and her previous marriage was in subsistence and that the said factum of her previous marriage had been concealed by her. It has been submitted that thereafter respondent No.4 left the

company of the petitioner and has started pressurizing the petitioner in one way or another and although the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 01.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.2, but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension or threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously preferably within a period of '**three months**' from today.
