It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that after the death of the father of the petitioner in the year 1993, he has submitted a representation for sanction of mutation in his favour as detailed in para 2 of the petition. When the same was not done, petitioner filed a representation to the Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar, on 27.08.2018 (Annexure P-3) but till date, no decision thereon has been taken. He submits that the matter is still pending with the Assistant Collector Ist Grade-cum-Tehsildar, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar, without any response

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents No.2 to 4 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as projected by him in his representation dated 27.08.2018 (Annexure P-3), within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, with direction to respondent No.2 – The Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar, respondent No.3 – The Sub Divisional Magistrate, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar and respondent No.4 – The Assistant Collector Ist Grade-cum-Tehsildar, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar, to consider and decide the representation dated 27.08.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
