Heard.

It is alleged that petitioner along with his co-accused were carrying cows for slaughter. On receipt of secret information, naka was put. The accused tried to fled away and when the police party chased the truck, the accused left the truck and ran away. On checking, 15 thin, weak and mercilessly tied oxen were found. The said oxen were allegedly being taken for slaughtering.

Considering the gravity of the offence, no ground to grant anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
