Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No 58 dated 07.07.2016 under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

It comes out that petitioner absented from the trial Court on 11.07.2018 and is absconding. Now, he has applied for anticipatory bail.

I am of the view that petitioner is absconding for the last five months. No ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

However, petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court and seek regular bail. In case, he does not surrender before the trial Court within one week, the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana shall ensure that petitioner is arrested and produced before the trial Court.
