This petition has been filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. seeking maintenance allowance from the respondent on the grounds mentioned therein.

The matter was taken up for hearing on 23.01.2017 and on request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the matter was adjourned to 03.03.2017 and later on to 20.4.2017 and thereafter adjourned to 12.07.2017. On 12.07.2017, no one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned to 29.08.2017, on which date again, a request was made by the proxy counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned to 14.09.2017. Thereafter on 14.09.2017 once again, no one came present on petitioner's behalf even in second round and the matter stood adjourned to 10.10.2017. On 10.10.2017, proxy counsel appeared on behalf of the petitioner and sought some time to argue the matter stating some possibility of settlement and the matter was adjourned to 07.12.2017. On 07.12.2017, again no one appeared on behalf

of the petitioner despite calling in second round and in the interest of justice, matter was adjourned to 19.02.2018 but on 19.02.2018, the matter was again adjourned to 01.03.2018, on request made by the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner. On 01.03.2018, adjournment was sought and the matter was adjourned to 19.03.2018. On 19.03.2018, again no one came present on behalf of the petitioner and in the interest of justice, the matter was adjourned to 25.05.2018.

The matter is listed for today i.e. 25.05.2018 and again no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the above, it appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the case.

Under these circumstances, this Court is left with no option but to dismiss the present petition for want of prosecution.

Ordered accordingly.
