Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was released on anticipatory bail by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Bathinda vide order dated 08.09.2017. Thereafter, challan was presented on 04.06.2018. The case was fixed for framing of charge on 31.07.2018. The petitioner could not appear before the trial Court as he was lodged in Central Jail, Bathinda in other case FIR No.60 dated 23.07.2018 under Section 307 IPC, under Arms Act and Excise Act, Police Station - Kotfatta, Distt. Bathinda. The bail order passed in favour of the petitioner was cancelled and warrant of arrest was issued against him. Learned counsel submits that thereafter, petitioner filed application for anticipatory bail, which was disposed of with a direction to appear before the trial Court within a period of seven days, but the petitioner could not appear because he was suffering from Dengue. Petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the documents available on record.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on the next date of hearing *i.e.* 16.01.2019 and move application for regular bail and in case he does so, the trial Court is directed to consider the regular bail application and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
