GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek issuance of direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to ensure that the petitioners or other members of their family are not implicated in some false case and also protection of their life and liberty.

The learned counsel for the petitioners have submitted that son of the petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Sandeep Singh has been involved in FIR No.133 dated 27.8.2018 registered under Sections 302, 148, 149 and 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran and that now the police is pressurizing the petitioners No.1 and 3 to produce their son and also

threatening that in case Sandeep Singh is not produced, the petitioners and other members of their family would be implicated in some other case.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion as regards the veracity of allegations levelled by the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2) dated 15.11.2018, moved by petitioners, expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then it be ensured that the petitioners or other members of their family are not unduly harassed. In case the petitioners or other members of their family are required to be associated with any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from them, then a prior notice in terms of Section 160 Cr.P.C. be afforded to them.

A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-2) dated 15.11.2018 be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously
