Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions *inter alia* to be issued to S.H.O., Police Station, Hajipur, Hoshiarpur on the ground that the private respondents No.4 to 9/accused in the FIR No.60 dated 25.09.2018 registered at the instance of the petitioner/complainant are threatening the petitioner and his family members to cause further bodily damage/injuries to him and/or his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the accused in the said FIR are also pressurizing the petitioner to enter into a compromise so that the further criminal proceedings against them are dropped.

Keeping in view the contentions of the learned counsel as noted above as also having perused the pleadings on record, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. S.H.O. Police Station, Hajipur, Hoshiarpur that the

representation dated 06.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner seeking protection of life and liberty be got duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioner. It is clarified that this order shall neither be treated as a stamp of this Court on the allegations/apprehension expressed by the petitioner nor any reflection on the merits of the allegations inter se parties herein.

Petition stands disposed of.
