The petitioner apprehends that the police is not fairly investigating FIR No.200 dated 28.10.2018, registered at Police Station Hasanpur, District Palwal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the complaint of the petitioner FIR No.184 dated 25.9.2018 was registered against the complainant. As a counter-blast, the complainant has got the present FIR registered by suffering a self-inflicted injury. The police is colluding with the complainant and therefore, direction needs to be given to the police to conduct a fair investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to place on record any material to show that the police is biased against the petitioner. Thus, I cannot accept the submission made by him.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with the observation that it is the duty of the police to investigate every case fairly and without any bias and that in the present FIR also, investigation will be done accordingly.
