The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.62 dated 28.5.2016, registered at Police Station Lopoke Amritsar, District Amritsar, under Sections 304/34 IPC and Sections 25/27/30 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although, the petitioner was named in the FIR, the police found him innocent and thus, kept his name in column No.2. The petitioner has been regularly appearing before the Investigating Officer and has been cooperating with him. Now, he has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 7.8.2018. Thus, he apprehends that he may be arrested.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice of motion.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 10.1.2019 and move an application for regular bail. On his doing so, the trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
