Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter alia, contends that the petitioners are ready and willing to let their house be demolished in order to widen the proposed road as State Highway No.12-A as per layout plan (Annexure P-11). However, he contends that he may be given some time to vacate his house and reasonable time to construct the house. He further states that the respondents have not assessed the value of the construction of their house to be computed towards the compensation to which they are entitled by virtue of the land acquisition alongwith construction thereof. He further contends that both the petitioners have submitted separate representations dated 10.12.2018 to the Deputy Commissioner, Mohali (Annexure P-12 and P-13 respectively) but the same have not been adverted to by the Deputy Commissioner, Mohali.

In view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to pass an order in accordance with law on the representations (Annexure P-12 and P-13) submitted by the petitioners and also keeping in view the averments of the present writ petition by treating the petition as a supplementary representation within a period of 30 days. Until passing of the order by the Deputy Commissioner, Mohali, the respondents are directed not to take any coercive action qua the property of the petitioners.
