Sarabjit Kaur has filed this petition for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.16 dated 10.02.2018 under Sections 406 and 420 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot on the basis of complaint made by Lovejeet Singh son of Resham Singh wherein it is alleged that the petitioner along with her husband, namely, Amandeep Singh assured the complainant that he would be sent to Canada and would be provided a job. Upon this the complainant parted away with a sum of ₹13,00,000/- paid on different occasions.

Learned counsel has contended that she is wife of Amandeep Singh and has been falsely implicated, however, it is not disputed that the amount in question was transferred in the Joint Account maintained by the petitioner with her husband-Amandeep Singh. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner further contended that her husband has entered into a compromise with the complainant on 11.09.2017 whereby he has agreed to return the amount.

After examination of the material on record and the contents of the FIR, it is found that the allegations are serious. It is also noticed that there is another case registered against the petitioner of the similar nature through FIR No.209 dated 25.08.2018, therefore, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
