Sarabjit Kaur has filed this petition for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.209 dated 25.08.2018 registered on the basis of complaint made by Rajinder Singh Johan wherein it is alleged that the petitioner along with her husband, namely, Amandeep Singh assured the complainant that he would be sent to Canada along with his three children and demanded ₹19,00,000/- for each child. According to the complainant, the amount was paid through cheque and transferred in the account given by Amandeep Singh (husband of the petitioner).

It is further alleged that accused sent one visa to the complainant and upon verification it was found that said visa was fake. Upon this the accused was asked to return the money, however, money has not been returned.

After hearing the learned counsel and examining the FIR, it is found that the allegations are serious. In this case, a sum of ₹6,26,000/- has

been parted away by the complainant. Two cheques for a sum of ₹3,00,000/- and ₹2,00,000/- respectively were allegedly encashed in the name Sarabjit Kaur (petitioner). Besides, there is another case registered against the petitioner of the similar nature through FIR No.16 dated 10.02.2018, therefore, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
