The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 12.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
