In the present petition, the petitioner is claiming that he apprehends danger to his life and liberty.

The allegations have been made in the present petition without attaching any corroborating evidence to support the same. Even representation dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) which has been stated to be filed, is undated. Annexure P-6 is the receipt of sending representation (Annexure P-5) to the concerned authorities, which has been sent from this Court, which clearly indicates that the representation was sent on the day when the petition has been filed. There is no representation which has been sent to respondents No. 3 and 4.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that a representation will be made to respondents No. 3 and 4 with regard to the apprehension which the petitioner is having in respect of danger to his life

and liberty.

In case, any such representation is filed by the petitioner with respondents No. 3 and 4 within a period of one week from today, respondents No. 3 and 4 shall consider the same and pass appropriate order and in case any merit is found in the representation, it shall be ensured that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
