By way of filing this petition, petitioners seek issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.1 was married to respondent No.4-Raj Kumar when she was a minor. The learned counsel has submitted that as of now petitioner No.1 is aged 20 years and has two children out of the wedlock with respondent No.4. It is submitted that respondent No.4 is a drunkard and had been torturing petitioner No.1 and had been giving beatings to her time and again and due to which she chose to live with petitioner No.2 out of her own free will along with her children. It has been submitted that respondent No.4 is however threatening to eliminate the petitioners. Petitioner No.1 had submitted a representation to respondent No.2 but no step has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation Annexure P-3 expeditiously. Further, in case there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners in any manner.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-3 be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful.
