The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to give sufficient time to the petitioner for making the payment of debt that is pending.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to approach the bank at the first instance or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to them in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to them, in accordance with law.
