It is stated that the representation in this case was made by the petitioner but was not decided.

In our opinion, since the elections of the Gram Panchayat is to be held in the near future, we think it would be appropriate for the authority to decide the grievance/representation by passing a speaking / detailed order after granting opportunity of hearing.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, we direct the competent authority to hear and decide the same and pass a speaking / detailed order within a period of 48 hours.

It shall be the duty of the learned State counsel to convey today's order to the concerned quarters, duly attested by the Bench Secretary of this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
