It is contended that petitioner No. 1 Diksha, aged about 20 years has married petitioner No. 2 Mohit Kumar, aged about 22 years, against the wishes of her family members, arrayed as respondents No. 4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that private respondents are threatening to interfere in their marital life. Hence, the petitioners are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no. 2 Superintendent of Police, Ambala to take necessary steps to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardised at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the petitioners and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
