This writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for direction to respondent No. 1-Financial Commissioner, Haryana to hear the appeal of the appellant/petitioner immediately in the case bearing ROA No. 06/2018/2019 (Annexure P-3), titled as ***Rakesh Vs. Ashok Kumar***, instituted on 18.12.2018 and fixed for 09.01.2019, with a further prayer that order dated 26.11.2018 be stayed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, restricts his arguments to the extent that a direction be issued to respondent No. 1/appellate authority – Financial Commissioner, Haryana to decide the application for stay, filed along with the appeal, i.e. fixed for 09.01.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that an appeal has been filed challenging the order dated 26.11.2018 on 18.12.2018 and the next date fixed is 09.01.2019.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1 – Financial Commissioner, Haryana to decide

the application for stay, filed along with the said appeal, on 09.01.2019 or within a period of three days thereafter.

Till the time respondent No. 1 – Financial Commissioner, Haryana passes an order, the petitioner shall not be divested of the charge of the post of Numberdar.
