Today at the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he restricts his prayer to the extent that some direction may be issued to the learned trial Court to decide his bail application in case he surrenders before the same.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court in respect of the proceedings arising out from Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act and moves an application for grant of bail, the learned trial Court shall dispose of the same expeditiously preferably within the day of filing itself in accordance with law.
