The petitioner has filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 against respondent No.5. Due to the filing of this complaint, it is alleged that the said respondent is threatening the petitioner and he consequently fears for his life. A detailed representation (Annexure P-4) has been submitted to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued to respondents No.4 to 7.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to send the representation (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3, who is further directed to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary within a period of eight weeks.
