DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was earlier appearing regularly before the trial Court but only on one date i.e 04.12.2018, he could not appear because of his ailment. The application moved by him for exemption from his personal appearance was dismissed. The circumstances were beyond his reach and just because of that, he could not appear on 04.12.2018. Learned senior counsel further submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear regularly on each and every date and also to abide by all terms and conditions to be imposed by this Court or by the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Notice on behalf of respondent-Central Bureau of Investigation has been accepted by Mr. Sumeet Goel, Advocate, who has opposed grant of bail of the petitioner on the ground that prescription is something different, whereas, the petitioner is claiming something else. The *bona fide* of the petitioner is not there to show the nature of ailment which shows his conduct.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the impugned order as well as other documents available on the file.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and in the interest of justice, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e 19.12.2018 and in case, he appears before the trial Court on said date, he shall be released on bail to its satisfaction subject to deposit of Rs.25,000/-, as costs with the trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner will submit an undertaking before the trial Court that he will appear on each and every date and would abide by any terms and conditions to be imposed by it.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
