The petitioner has approached this Court by filing writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash the order dated 12.11.2018 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw present petition with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the proceedings under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 by the District Magistrate-respondent No.2 (Annexure P-8) before the appropriate forum or to avail any other remedy as may be available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to her, in accordance with law.
