Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is undergoing the sentence for 12 years in case FIR No.65 dated 22.04.2013 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda. He states that the petitioner applied for emergency parole on the ground of death of his father, before respondent No.4-The Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, District Bathinda who recommended the case to respondent No.3- District Magistrate, Moga. Then District Magistrate, Moga sent the same to SSP, Moga vide letter No.3257 dated 13.12.2018. However, the SSP, Moga has not sent the report.
