Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take legal action on the complainants made by the petitioner against private respondents No.5 to 9 and to act upon the representations (Annexure P-4 and P-5) made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 08.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guhla, District Kaithal and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal is directed to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, but considering the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the contents of representation dated 08.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to act in accordance with law.
