In the present case, the petitioner has approached this Court seeking the release of the retiral benefits which the petitioner is entitled for after he superannuated on 30.06.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite the fact that more than five months have elapsed but still, not even a single penny has been released to the petitioner and there is no impediment in the release of the pensionary benefits as there is no inquiry or any criminal proceedings pending against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
