The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0195 dated 25.08.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 34 IPC (offence under Section 307 was deleted later on) at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The case of the prosecution is that on 23.08.2018 at about 9.15 P.M when Deepak Kumar-complainant was closing his shop then Jasbir Singh @ Kaka-petitioner armed with sickle, Navdeep Singh S/o Jasbir Singh armed with cutter, Ujjawal Singh S/o Jasbir Singh armed with cutter and Lucky armed with iron-road and two unknown persons armed with sickle came to the shop of the complainant and inflicted injuries upon him.

More than thirteen injuries have been inflicted on the person of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relied upon the inquiry report in which it has been found that Ujjawal Singh S/o Jasbir Singh, and Lucky servant of Jasbir Singh were found innocent.

Moreover, the State counsel has also produced the report of hospital in which it transpires that the nature of injuries attributed to the petitioner are grievous in nature and dangerous to life.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, and the alleged nature of grievous injuries attributed to the petitioner no case is made out for granting anticipatory bail to him.

Dismissed.
