Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.96 dated 12.10.2018, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 323, 341, 325 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station DLF-3, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

It is not in dispute that the offences punishable under Section 307 IPC stands deleted. FIR sustains only for the other offences except 506 IPC, which are bailable.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
