Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and three copies of the petition have been supplied to him in the Court.

Let petitioner No.1, respondent Nos.4 and 5 be relegated to the Mediation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court today itself at 11:00 a.m.

For report of the Mediation Centre, to come up after lunch. ”

In compliance of the aforesaid order, report from the Mediator has been received, which reads as under:-

“ Both the parties have settled their dispute by way of settlement, which is enclosed with the file. As such, the case be sent back to the Hon'ble High Court for further proceedings. ”

Perusal of the report of the Mediator reveals that both the parties have settled their dispute amicably and now there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

The above fact is duly acknowledged by learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from his clients who are present in the Court, and he wishes to withdraw the present petition.
