The petitioners have approached this Court by filing writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing the demand notice dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-1 colly) issued by respondent No.2.

2. A perusal of the writ petition shows that petitioners have not even filed any objections in terms of Section 13(3A) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002. Further, there is no document placed on record to show that the petitioners have approached the bank for relief claimed in the writ petition at the first instance.

3. Accordingly, we do not find any justification to entertain the present writ petition at this stage and the same is hereby dismissed.
