All the petitioners are working as Extension Lecturers on contract basis as per details given in para 2 of the petition. Their grievance is that they should not be replaced and relieved from services by respondents due to transfer/deputation of regular Lecturers from other college.

The petitioners have placed on record their experience certificates (Annexures P-1 to P-4).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue till regular appointments are made and petitioners shall not be replaced on the basis of transfer of regular employees. It is however made clear that if no regular employee joins, then the petitioners can only be replaced if they are ineligible and they can be replaced by

eligible qualified Extension Lecturers as per the judgment passed in **CWP-**
