The petitioners have prayed for the issuance a writ in the nature of mandamus for seeking direction to respondent No. 1 to decide the appeal and application for stay, bearing ROR No. 456 to 461 of 2017-18, filed against the order dated 09.03.2017, passed by the Collector, Bhiwani, which is pending for 19.12.2018 as the petitioners are afraid that they may not be dispossessed by respondent No. 2 on the ground that they have failed to prove their ownership/title over the land in question about which respondent No. 4 had filed the petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act, 1961 (for short 'the Act').

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Moudgil, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and 2. The kind of order which we are proposing to pass would not require any notice to respondents No. 3 and 4 because petitioners are only making an innocuous prayer to direct respondent No. 1, who is seized of their

revision petition and the application for stay, which is already fixed for 19.12.2018 to be decided on the same day.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances mentioned in the writ petition and narrated before us, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1, seized of the revision petition and the application for stay (ROR No. 456 to 461 of 2017-18), filed by the petitioners, which are listed on 19.12.2018, to decide the same and in case, there is difficulty in deciding the revision petition itself then the application for stay must be decided on the said date. Till then, parties shall maintain status-quo.
