The petitioner is aggrieved allegedly because the complainant after receiving the cheque amount left the country without compounding the offence. Meanwhile, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person and thus, the police is out to arrest him.

The present petition has been filed for quashing of the complaint on the basis of compromise. Offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 is compoundable and as such present quashing petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to challenge the order vide which he has been declared as proclaimed person.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforementioned liberty.
