Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is facing trial before learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali under Sections 307/323/324/326/427/450/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, SAS Nagar. He further contends that petitioner absented on 8.8.2018.

It is claimed that the petitioner was sick and suffering from chicken pox. However, the order of the trial Court shows that petitioner did not appear on subsequent dates i.e. 11.9.2018, 18.10.2018 and 17.11.2018 when the proceedings under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure were initiated. Thereafter, he applied for anticipatory bail which was dismissed by the trial Court on 20.11.2018.

Considering the fact that the petitioner remained absent for three dates and moved to the trial Court for anticipatory bail when the proceedings under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure was

initiated, there is no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

Dismissed.

Let the petitioner immediately surrender before the trial Court and apply for grant of regular bail.
