Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0148 dated 01.11.2018 registered under Sections 420, 406, 120B IPC at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 14.11.2018. The allegation against the petitioner is that he was mediator in facilitating the marriage between the parties, for which, an amount of Rs.1 lakh was paid to him.
