The bunch of cases are listed before this Court today where the parties/counsels after filing those cases had not taken back the paper book after objections were raised by the Registry. As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel / party, who filed it, to be re-filed within a total period of 40 days. On failure, the case is to be listed before the Court for orders.

Learned counsel for the appellants submitted that the paper book be returned to him as he is ready and willing to remove the objections to re-file the same.

The aforesaid petition was filed on 14.5.2015 and the Registry had returned the same with objections on 1.6.2015, to be re-filed within within a maximum period of 40 days after removing objections.

As a matter of indulgence, the counsel is permitted to take back the paper book to be re-filed within two weeks thereafter. In any case, he will have to explain the huge delay in taking back the paper book after objections were raised by the Registry and re-filing thereof after huge delay.
