Prayer made in the present application is for review of the order dated 06.08.2018 passed by this Court in CWP-14068-2015. The present application has been filed even after delay of 57 days of passing of the impugned order.

Learned counsel for the applicant contended that despite best efforts and due diligence, applicant-respondent No.2 could not produce the documentary evidence regarding gainful employment and after passing of the order on 06.08.2018, the applicant made efforts and came across certain facts, which were not in his knowledge and as such, directions may be issued to the petitioner to produce those facts regarding employment.

Heard.

The order, which is sought to be reviewed, was passed after considering the detailed averments of the parties available on file and arguments having been advanced by both sides. This review application is

not maintainable on the ground that certain facts have come to the knowledge. If some notice is issued to the petitioner, certain more facts can be brought before the Court and the same may come with the knowledge of the applicant and for that purpose, review application is not maintainable, as per view taken by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Parsion Devi vs. Sumitri Devi, 1997 (4) R.C.R (Civil) 458.** This Court does not find any illegality in the judgment passed by the Court, which may warrant any interference by way of present review application.

In view of the above, there is no ground for condonation of delay of 57 days in filing the review application. Consequently, the review application stands dismissed being without any merit and having been filed after such a long delay.
