RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Code') seeking issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Earlier the present petitioner along with two more persons had filed a petition under Section 482 of the Code vide *CRM-M-35254-2018* for issuance of direction to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents.

In said petition, this court passed the following order:-

“Petitioner No.1-Sushil Kumar is already married to one Poonam who is still alive and their marriage still subsists. He has two daughters from first marriage. He claims that Jeba Bakhtiar was residing with him. Today, he has stated that he has friendship with Jeba Bakhtiar petitioner No.3 through internet.

He has been asked to show his bonafide by depositing Rs.1 lac in the name of Jeba Bakhtiar petitioner No.3 in the shape of FDR in some nationalized bank.

List on 26.3.2019.

Interim order to continue.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the said order has not been complied with as Sushil Kumar failed to deposit an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of Jeba Bakhtiar in the shape of FDR. The said petition is still pending for 26.03.2019 and interim order has already been issued.

This petition appears to be abuse to the process of law.

Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
