For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is supported by an affidavit, delay of 417 days in filing the review application is condoned.

CM stands disposed of.

RA No.24-CII of 2018

Prayer in the application is for review of the order dated 26.10.2016 passed in the aforementioned appeal on the premise that this Court had enhanced the compensation of the acquired land from ₹6,000/- per sq.yard to ₹30,000/- per sq.yard along with statutory benefits in terms of order dated 5.9.2016 passed in Review Application No.213-CII of 2016 in

FAO No.8650 of 2014. Thereafter, the applicant had filed a review of judgment dated 19.5.2016 passed in FAO No.8090 of 2014 and order dated 5.9.2016 passed in Review Application No.213-CII of 2016 in FAO No.8650 of 2014, which, vide order dated 20.12.2017 had been partly allowed and the amount of compensation was reduced from ₹30,000/- to ₹26,000/- per sq.yard .

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and appraised the paper book.

Since this Court, vide order dated 20.12.2017 passed in connected matters, had reduced the amount of compensation from ₹30,000/- to ₹26,000/- per sq.yard., the present review application is also allowed and the amount of compensation is ordered to be reduced from ₹30,000/- to ₹26,000/- per sq.yard with all statutory benefits as per the ratio decidendi culled out in **M/s Golden Iron & Steel Forging Versus Union of India, 2011 (4) RCR (Civil) 375.**

It would be in the fitness of things that the wisdom may dawn upon the officers at the helm of affairs to comply with the order in letter and spirit in order to save the State Exchequer from burden of payment of interest.
