I have heard learned counsel for the review-appellant.

The application filed for condoning delay of 1454 days was dismissed by this Court after considering the ground pleaded in the application for condonation of delay. It was found that the ground as stated in the application does not fall within the definition of sufficient ground for condoning huge delay of 1454 days.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that he has a very good case on merits. Once, the appellant is unable to justify the delay in filing of the appeal, the appellant cannot be heard on merits. This Court has already considered the assertions made in the application seeking condonation of delay. Relevant paragraph of the application has been re-produced. The Court has formed an opinion on reading of the application that the grounds as pleaded in the application seeking condonation of delay are not sufficient. Hence, there is no ground to review the order dated 01.12.2017.

Review application is dismissed.
